SUPPLIER COMPLIANCE

We hereby confirm that all the co-extrusion films, vacuum pouches manufactured by SunrisePak are covered by the following regulations:

FDA

All of the raw materials used in the making of the films/pouches are approved for food contact according to the FDA/USDA standards by the material manufacturers and comply with requirements set forth in the FDA/USDA regulations 21 CFR section 177.1520 (Polyethylene), 177.1360 (EVOH), 175.105 (Adhesives), 177.1500 (Polyamide), 177.1330 (Ionomer) and 177.1350, 177.1570 (EP film).

EEC

All of the raw materials used in the making of the films/pouches conform EU Commission Regulation EU 10/2011 (including amendments) and to regulation (EC) No.1935/2004 of the European parliament and the council of 24 October 2004 and 2004/19/CE directive and directive 200272/EC, Directive 67/548/EEC, official journal of EC NO 175/22 and amendments up to 2002/17/EC.
